## History

The Oregon Volunteer Firemans' Association was organized in 1958. The name was changed to Oregon Volunteer Firefighters' Association in 1976 when it became an independent organization. The first independent OVFA conference was held in Hood River in 1979. The OVFA constitution was changed in 1998 to include "Emergency Service Providers" as "Firefighters."

The Board of Directors is elected at the annual conference each year and serves as the governing body of OVFA. It includes the President, 1st and 2nd Vice Presidents, Past President, Secretary/Treasurer, two Directors. The OVFA Ambassador Program represent geographic area's Oregon by providing face to face contact to membership and the Board.



## Membership and Dues

Active OVFA membership is open to any agency whose membership contains Volunteer Fire or EMS Providers. Associate and sustaining memberships are also available for retired Volunteers and organizations that represent manufacturing, vendors or fire service related organizations.
